1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Section 82.005, Government Code, is amended to  
1-11 read as follows:

1-12 Sec. 82.005. BOARD COMPENSATION. (a) The supreme court  
1-13 shall set the compensation of each member of the Board of Law  
1-14 Examiners, excluding reasonable and necessary actual expenses, at  
1-15 an amount that does not exceed \$30,000 [~~\$20,000~~] a year.

1-16 (b) Subchapter B, Chapter 659, does not apply to the  
1-17 compensation set under this section.

1-18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
