A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to posting notice online of the meetings of certain
3	governmental bodies.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 551, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 551.056 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 551.056. ADDITIONAL POSTING REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN
8	MUNICIPALITIES, COUNTIES, SCHOOL DISTRICTS, JUNIOR COLLEGE
9	DISTRICTS, AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATIONS. (a) This section applies
10	only to a governmental body or economic development corporation
11	that maintains an Internet website or for which an Internet website
12	is maintained. This section does not apply to a governmental body
13	described by Section 551.001(3)(D).
14	(b) In addition to the other place at which notice is
15	required to be posted by this subchapter, the following
16	governmental bodies and economic development corporations must
17	also concurrently post notice of a meeting on the Internet website
18	of the governmental body or economic development corporation:
19	(1) a municipality;
20	(2) a county;
21	(3) a school district;
22	(4) the governing body of a junior college or junior
23	college district, including a college or district that has changed
24	its name in accordance with Chapter 130, Education Code; and

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1	(5) a development corporation organized under the
2	Development Corporation Act of 1979 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas
3	<u>Civil Statutes).</u>
4	(c) The following governmental bodies and economic
5	development corporations must also concurrently post the agenda for
6	the meeting on the Internet website of the governmental body or
7	economic development corporation:
8	(1) a municipality with a population of 48,000 or
9	more;
10	(2) a county with a population of 65,000 or more;
11	(3) a school district that contains all or part of the
12	area within the corporate boundaries of a municipality with a
13	population of 48,000 or more;
14	(4) the governing body of a junior college district,
15	including a district that has changed its name in accordance with
16	Chapter 130, Education Code, that contains all or part of the area
17	within the corporate boundaries of a municipality with a population
18	of 48,000 or more; and
19	(5) a development corporation organized under the
20	Development Corporation Act of 1979 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas
21	<u>Civil Statutes) that was created by or for:</u>
22	(A) a municipality with a population of 48,000 or
23	more; or
24	(B) a county or district that contains all or
25	part of the area within the corporate boundaries of a municipality
26	with a population of 48,000 or more.
27	(d) The validity of a posted notice of a meeting or an agenda

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1	by a governmental body or economic development corporation subject
2	to this section that made a good faith attempt to comply with the
3	requirements of this section is not affected by a failure to comply
4	with a requirement of this section that is due to a technical
5	problem beyond the control of the governmental body or economic
6	development corporation.
7	SECTION 2. Section 551.056, Government Code, as added by
8	this Act, applies only in relation to a meeting held on or after
9	January 4, 2006.
10	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2006.

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
