5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 551, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 551.056 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 551.056. ADDITIONAL POSTING REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN
8	MUNICIPALITIES, COUNTIES, SCHOOL DISTRICTS, JUNIOR COLLEGE
9	DISTRICTS, AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATIONS. (a) This section applies
10	only to a governmental body or economic development corporation
11	that maintains an Internet website or for which an Internet website
12	is maintained.
13	(b) In addition to the other place at which notice is
14	required to be posted by this subchapter, the following
15	governmental bodies and economic development corporations must
16	also concurrently post notice of a meeting on the Internet website
17	of the governmental body or economic development corporation:
18	(1) a municipality;
19	(2) a county;
20	(3) a school district;
21	(4) the governing body of a junior college or junior
22	college district, including a college or district that has changed
23	its name in accordance with Chapter 130, Education Code; and
24	(5) a development corporation organized under the

- 3 (c) The following governmental bodies and economic
- 4 development corporations must also concurrently post the entire

- 8 more;
- 9 (2) a county that contains all or part of the area
- within the corporate boundaries of a municipality with a population
- 11 of 48,000 or more;
- 12 (3) a school district that contains all or part of the
- 13 area within the corporate boundaries of a municipality with a
- 14 population of 48,000 or more;
- 15 (4) the governing body of a junior college district,
- 16 including a district that has changed its name in accordance with
- 17 Chapter 130, Education Code, that contains all or part of the area
- within the corporate boundaries of a municipality with a population
- 19 of 48,000 or more; and
- 20 (5) a development corporation organized under the
- 21 Development Corporation Act of 1979 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas
- 22 <u>Civil Statutes</u>), that was created by or for:
- 23 (A) a municipality with a population of 48,000 or
- 24 more; or
- 25 (B) a county or district that contains all or
- 26 part of the area within the corporate boundaries of a municipality
- with a population of 48,000 or more.
