## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the method of selecting public members to serve on a 3 county's salary grievance committee. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 152.015(b), Local Government Code, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6 (b) Before the meeting, the county clerk shall place on a 7 separate slip the name of each person who served on a grand jury in 8 the county during the preceding calendar year. At the meeting the 9 slips shall be folded, placed in an appropriate container, and 10 The county judge shall draw at random a number of slips 11 mixed. 12 equal to the number of public members needed for the committee and 13 the clerk shall keep a list of the names drawn [shall announce the 14 names on the slips]. At the meeting the county judge may repeat 15 this process and make a list of alternates to be kept by the clerk. A person whose name is drawn becomes a member of the committee or an 16 alternate on submitting written acceptance to the clerk. If a 17 person refuses or is unable to serve on the committee, a replacement 18 shall be appointed from the list of alternates. If the list of 19 alternates is exhausted or does not exist, a replacement shall be 20 21 selected at the next regular or called commissioners court meeting 22 by random selection of a slip from the remaining slips. This process shall be repeated until the required number of public 23 members is selected. The names of the persons who are drawn and 24
