- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 54.5441 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 54.5441. RECREATIONAL AND HEALTH FACILITIES FEE;
- 8 MIDWESTERN STATE UNIVERSITY. (a) Beginning with the 2007 spring
- 9 semester, the board of regents of Midwestern State University may
- 10 charge each student registered at the university a recreational and
- 11 health facilities fee not to exceed \$130 for each semester of the
- 12 regular term or summer session of 12 weeks or longer and not to
- 13 <u>exceed \$65 for each summer session of less than 12 weeks.</u>
- 14 (b) The recreational and health facilities fee may be used
- 15 only for financing, constructing, operating, maintaining, and
- 16 improving a student recreation center or health center at the
- 17 university.
- 18 (c) The recreational and health facilities fee is in
- 19 addition to any other fee the board is authorized by law to impose.
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies
- 21 beginning with fees imposed for the 2007 spring semester.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
