- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 2175.125, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 2175.125. DIRECT TRANSFER; MONITORING BY COMMISSION.
- 9 (a) During the 10 business days after the date the property is
- 10 posted on the comptroller's website, a state agency, political
- 11 subdivision, or assistance organization may coordinate directly
- 12 with the reporting state agency for a transfer of the property at a
- 13 price established by the reporting agency.
- (b) During the 10 business days described by Subsection (a),
- 15 the reporting state agency shall coordinate its activities with the
- 16 commission to allow the commission to monitor the reporting state
- 17 agency's activities under this section. The commission shall
- 18 ensure that the reporting state agency is ethically and legally
- 19 conducting a transfer according to the best economic interests of
- 20 <u>the state.</u>
- (c) If property is transferred under this section, the
- transferring agency shall report the transaction to the commission.
- 23 The report must include a description of the property transferred,
- 24 the reasons for the transfer, the price for the property

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- 1 transferred, and the recipient of the property transferred.
- 2 (d) If the commission determines that a violation of a state
- 3 law or rule has occurred based on the monitoring or the report, the
- 4 commission shall report the violation to the Legislative Budget
- 5 Board.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
