## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 51.0075, Property Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (d) to read as 7 follows:
  - mortgagee may appoint or may authorize a mortgage servicer to appoint a [perpetual] substitute trustee or substitute trustees to succeed to all title, powers, and duties of the original trustee. A mortgagee or mortgage servicer may make an appointment or authorization under this subsection by power of attorney, corporate resolution, or other written instrument. [The power of attorney or written instrument must be signed by the mortgagee's representative, acknowledged, and sworn to with a jurat.]
- (d) A mortgage servicer may authorize an attorney to appoint

  a substitute trustee or substitute trustees on behalf of a

  mortgagee under Subsection (c).
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a security instrument or other contract executed on or after the effective date of this Act and to a security instrument or other contract executed before the date of this Act that does not conflict with the changes in law made by this Act. A security instrument or

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- 1 other contract executed before the effective date of this Act that
- 2 conflicts with the changes in law made by this Act is governed by
- 3 the law in effect at the time the security instrument or other
- 4 contract was executed, and the former law is continued in effect for
- 5 that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
