A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to supplemental rebates for prescription drugs provided
- 3 under state health and human services programs.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 531.070(h), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (h) Subject to Subsection (i), the commission shall
- 8 negotiate with manufacturers and labelers[, including generic
- 9 manufacturers and labelers, obtain supplemental rebates for
- 10 prescription drugs provided under:
- 11 (1) the Medicaid vendor drug program in excess of the
- 12 Medicaid rebates required by 42 U.S.C. Section 1396r-8 and its
- 13 subsequent amendments;
- 14 (2) the child health plan program; and
- 15 (3) any other state program administered by the
- 16 commission or a health and human services agency, including
- 17 community mental health centers and state mental health hospitals.
- 18 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 19 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 20 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 21 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 22 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 23 waiver or authorization is granted.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
