## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the qualifications of and training and continuing
3	education for certain officials and personnel of career schools or
4	colleges.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 132, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 132.0551 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 132.0551. QUALIFICATIONS, TRAINING, AND CONTINUING
  9 EDUCATION REQUIRED. (a) Each director of admissions and each
  10 full-time instructor employed by a career school or college must
  11 meet the minimum qualification and training requirements
  12 established by commission rule.
- 13 <u>(b) The chief administrative officer of or an owner with</u>
  14 <u>supervisory authority over a career school or college must meet the</u>
  15 <u>minimum qualification and training requirements established by</u>
  16 commission rule.
- 17 <u>(c) The commission shall require a person described by</u>
  18 <u>Subsection (a) or (b) to complete not less than six hours each year</u>
  19 of continuing education applicable to the position.
- 20 <u>(d) The commission by rule shall establish the minimum</u>
  21 <u>qualification and training requirements and continuing education</u>
  22 requirements for each position to which this section applies.
- (e) In accordance with rules adopted for that purpose, the commission shall approve appropriate entities that the commission

- 1 determines are qualified to provide the continuing education or
- 2 training courses required by this section. In approving an entity
- 3 under this subsection, the commission shall consider the entity's
- 4 ability to offer a curriculum that:
- 5 (1) addresses the applicable requirements for the
- 6 positions for which the education or training is provided;
- 7 (2) addresses the statutes, rules, and federal
- 8 regulations or guidelines applicable to the positions;
- 9 (3) includes any criteria required to receive or
- 10 retain accreditation from a nationally recognized organization;
- 11 <u>and</u>
- 12 (4) addresses any other curriculum needs of a
- 13 continuing education or training course established under this
- 14 section.
- 15 (f) Each career school or college shall maintain records of
- 16 any continuing education or training received by school or college
- 17 officials or personnel and shall make the records available for
- 18 inspection during regular business hours on the premises of the
- 19 school. The records must indicate for which position the
- 20 continuing education or training was received.
- 21 (g) Subsections (a), (b), and (c) do not apply to a person
- 22 before September 1, 2006. The commission by rule shall prescribe
- 23 procedures by which a person described by Subsection (a) or (b) who
- 24 <u>is employed by a career school or college before that date may meet</u>
- 25 the requirements of the applicable subsection before that date.
- 26 This subsection expires January 1, 2007.
- 27 SECTION 2. Section 132.056, Education Code, is amended by

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- 1 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 2 <u>(g) Before the commission issues a certificate of approval</u>
- 3 or a renewal certificate of approval under this section, the
- 4 commission may require a career school or college to comply with the
- 5 requirements of Section 132.0551 and to submit evidence of that
- 6 compliance to the commission.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
