1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the service areas of the Alamo Community College
1-11 District and the Austin Community College District.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 130.162, Education Code, is amended to
1-14 read as follows:

1-15 Sec. 130.162. ALAMO COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT SERVICE
1-16 AREA. The service area of the Alamo Community College District
1-17 includes the territory within:

1-18 (1) Bexar, Bandera, Comal, ~~[Guadalupe]~~ Kendall,
1-19 Kerr, and Wilson counties; ~~[and]~~

1-20 (2) Atascosa County, except the territory within the
1-21 Pleasanton Independent School District; and

1-22 (3) Guadalupe County, except the territory within the
1-23 San Marcos Consolidated Independent School District.

1-24 SECTION 2. Section 130.166, Education Code, is amended to
1-25 read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 130.166. AUSTIN COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT SERVICE
1-27 AREA. The service area of the Austin Community College District
1-28 includes the territory within:

1-29 (1) Bastrop, Hays, Gillespie, Caldwell, and Blanco
1-30 counties;

1-31 (2) Travis County, except the territory within the
1-32 Marble Falls Independent School District;

1-33 (3) Williamson County, except the territory within the
1-34 Florence, Granger, Hutto, Taylor, and Thrall independent school
1-35 districts; ~~[and]~~

1-36 (4) the part of the Nixon-Smiley Consolidated
1-37 Independent School District located in Gonzales County; and

1-38 (5) the part of the San Marcos Consolidated
1-39 Independent School District located in Guadalupe County.

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-41 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-42 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-43 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-44 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
