- Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Article 1.06, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 5 6 amended to read as follows:
- Art. 1.06. SEARCHES AND SEIZURES. (a) The people shall be 7
- 8 secure in their persons, houses, papers and possessions from all
- unreasonable seizures or searches. No warrant to search any place 9
- or to seize any person or thing shall issue without describing them 10
- as near as may be, nor without probable cause supported by oath or 11
- 12 affirmation.

- 13 (b) A peace officer who stops a motor vehicle for any
- 14 alleged violation of a law or ordinance regulating traffic may not
- search the vehicle unless the peace officer: 15
- (1) has probable cause or another legal basis for the 16
- 17 search; or
- (2) obtains on a form that complies with Section 18
- 19 411.0207, Government Code, the written consent of the operator of
- the vehicle. 20
- SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 411, Government Code, is 21
- 22 amended by adding Section 411.0207 to read as follows:
- 23 Sec. 411.0207. GUIDELINES FOR FORMS INDICATING CONSENT TO
- 24 VEHICLE SEARCH. (a) The director by rule shall establish

- 1 requirements for a form used to obtain the consent of the operator
- of a motor vehicle under Article 1.06, Code of Criminal Procedure.
- 3 (b) At a minimum, the rules must require the form to
- 4 contain:
- 5 (1) a statement that the operator of the motor vehicle
- 6 fully understands that the operator may refuse to give the peace
- 7 officer consent to search the motor vehicle;
- 8 (2) a statement that the operator of the motor vehicle
- 9 is freely and voluntarily giving the peace officer consent to
- 10 search the motor vehicle;
- 11 (3) the time and date of the stop giving rise to the
- 12 search;
- 13 (4) a description of the motor vehicle to be searched;
- 14 and
- 15 (5) the name of each peace officer conducting the stop
- 16 <u>or search.</u>
- 17 SECTION 3. The director of the Department of Public Safety
- 18 of the State of Texas shall adopt the rules required by Section
- 19 411.0207, Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 20 December 1, 2005.
- 21 SECTION 4. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of
- this section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
- 23 (b) Article 1.06, Code of Criminal Procedure, as amended by
- this Act, takes effect January 1, 2006.
