- SECTION 1. Section 775.002, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsection (f) to read
- 8 (c) The colonia initiatives coordinator <u>shall</u> [may] work
  9 with the other agencies and local officials involved in colonia
  10 projects in the state to:
  - (1) coordinate efforts to address colonia issues;
- 12 (2) identify nonprofit self-help groups to help with colonia initiatives;
- 14 (3) set goals for each state fiscal year for colonia 15 initiatives in the state, including goals to:
- 16 (A) address easement problems; and
- 17 (B) ensure that water and wastewater connections
- 18 are extended from distribution lines to houses located in colonias;
- 19 (4) ensure that the goals set under this subsection 20 are met each state fiscal year; and
- (5) coordinate state outreach efforts to nonborder colonias and to political subdivisions capable of providing water and wastewater services to nonborder colonias.
- 24 (d) The following agencies shall designate an officer or

- 1 employee of the agency to serve as the agency's liaison for colonia
- 2 initiatives:
- 3 (1) the office of the attorney general;
- 4 (2) the [Texas] Department of State Health Services;
- 5 (3) the Texas Department of Housing and Community
- 6 Affairs;
- 7 (4) the Texas [Natural Resource Conservation]
- 8 Commission on Environmental Quality; [and]
- 9 (5) the Texas Water Development Board;
- 10 (6) the Office of Rural Community Affairs;
- 11 (7) the Office of State-Federal Relations;
- 12 (8) the Texas Department of Insurance; and
- 13 (9) the Texas Department of Transportation.
- 14 (f) In coordinating colonia initiatives under this section,
- 15 the coordinator shall consider the advice and recommendations of
- 16 the Colonia Resident Advisory Committee established under Section
- 2306.584.
- 18 SECTION 2. Chapter 775, Government Code, is amended by
- 19 adding Section 775.004 to read as follows:
- Sec. 775.004. DEVELOPMENT OF STRATEGY TO ASSIST COLONIA
- 21 RESIDENTS. (a) To improve services delivered to colonia
- 22 <u>residents</u>, the colonia initiatives coordinator shall work with the
- 23 <u>Colonia Resident Advisory Committee established under Section</u>
- 24 2306.584.
- 25 (b) The coordinator may establish an advisory committee
- 26 similar to the Colonia Resident Advisory Committee to supplement
- 27 the efforts of the Colonia Resident Advisory Committee by providing

- 1 representation for colonia residents in counties that are not
- 2 represented by a member of the Colonia Resident Advisory Committee.
- 3 (c) The coordinator shall consider the advice of the Colonia
- 4 Resident Advisory Committee and any committee established under
- 5 Subsection (b) regarding the needs of colonia residents.
- 6 (d) Based on the advice received under Subsection (c) and
- 7 any recommendations received from the agencies listed in Section
- 8 775.002(d), the coordinator shall define and develop a strategy to
- 9 address the needs of colonia residents and make recommendations to
- 10 the legislature based on that strategy. The coordinator shall
- 11 recommend appropriate programs, grants, and activities to the
- 12 <u>legislature.</u>
- SECTION 3. Section 2306.585, Government Code, is amended by
- 14 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 15 (c) The advisory committee shall advise the colonia
- initiatives coordinator as provided by Section 775.004.
- SECTION 4. (a) Not later than December 1, 2006, the colonia
- 18 initiatives coordinator shall submit a report to the lieutenant
- 19 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and each
- 20 member of the legislature.
- 21 (b) The report must:
- 22 (1) document:
- 23 (A) the recommendations provided by the Colonia
- 24 Resident Advisory Committee and any other similar committee to the
- 25 colonia initiatives coordinator; and
- 26 (B) the actions taken by the colonia initiatives
- 27 coordinator to address the recommendations;

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- 1 (2) outline a long-range plan to improve the quality
- of life of colonia residents and propose legislation to implement
- 3 the plan; and
- 4 (3) recommend appropriate programs, grants, and
- 5 activities to address the needs of colonia residents.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
