## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the coordination of colonia initiatives and services to
  3 colonia residents.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 775.002, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsection (f) to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (c) The colonia initiatives coordinator <a href="may">shall</a> [may] work
- 9 with the other agencies and local officials involved in colonia
- 10 projects in the state to:
- 11 (1) coordinate efforts to address colonia issues;
- 12 (2) identify nonprofit self-help groups to help with
- 13 colonia initiatives;
- 14 (3) set goals for each state fiscal year for colonia
- initiatives in the state, including goals to:
- 16 (A) address easement problems; and
- 17 (B) ensure that water and wastewater connections
- 18 are extended from distribution lines to houses located in colonias;
- 19 (4) ensure that the goals set under this subsection
- 20 are met each state fiscal year; and
- 21 (5) coordinate state outreach efforts to nonborder
- 22 colonias and to political subdivisions capable of providing water
- 23 and wastewater services to nonborder colonias.
- 24 (d) The following agencies shall designate an officer or

- 1 employee of the agency to serve as the agency's liaison for colonia
- 2 initiatives:
- 3 (1) the office of the attorney general;
- 4 (2) the <u>Department of State Health Services</u> [<del>Texas</del>
- 5 Department of Health];
  - 6 (3) the Texas Department of Housing and Community
- 7 Affairs;
- 8 (4) the Texas [Natural Resource Conservation]
- 9 Commission on Environmental Quality; [and]
- 10 (5) the Texas Water Development Board;
- 11 (6) the Office of Rural Community Affairs;
- 12 (7) the Office of State-Federal Relations;
- 13 (8) the Texas Department of Insurance; and
- 14 (9) the Texas Department of Transportation.
- (f) In coordinating colonia initiatives under this section,
- 16 the coordinator shall consider the advice and recommendations of
- 17 the colonia resident advisory committee established under Section
- 18 2306.584.
- 19 SECTION 2. Chapter 775, Government Code, is amended by
- 20 adding Section 775.004 to read as follows:
- 21 <u>Sec. 775.004. DEVELOPMENT OF STRATEGY TO ASSIST</u> COLONIA
- 22 RESIDENTS. (a) To improve services delivered to colonia
- 23 <u>residents, the colonia initiatives coordinator shall work with the</u>
- 24 colonia resident advisory committee established under Section
- 25 2306.584.
- 26 (b) The coordinator may establish an advisory committee
- 27 similar to the colonia resident advisory committee to supplement

- 1 the efforts of the colonia resident advisory committee by providing
- 2 representation for colonia residents in counties that are not
- 3 represented by a member of the colonia resident advisory committee.
- 4 (c) The coordinator shall consider the advice of the colonia
- 5 resident advisory committee and any committee established under
- 6 Subsection (b) regarding the needs of colonia residents.
- 7 (d) Based on the advice received under Subsection (c) and
- 8 any recommendations received from the agencies listed in Section
- 9 775.002(d), the coordinator shall define and develop a strategy to
- 10 address the needs of colonia residents and make recommendations to
- 11 the legislature based on that strategy. The coordinator shall
- 12 recommend appropriate programs, grants, and activities to the
- 13 legislature.
- SECTION 3. Section 2306.585, Government Code, is amended by
- 15 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 16 (c) The advisory committee shall advise the colonia
- initiatives coordinator as provided by Section 775.004.
- 18 SECTION 4. (a) Not later than December 1, 2006, the colonia
- 19 initiatives coordinator shall submit a report to the lieutenant
- 20 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and each
- 21 member of the legislature.
- 22 (b) The report must:
- 23 (1) document:
- 24 (A) the recommendations provided by the colonia
- 25 resident advisory committee and any other similar committee to the
- 26 colonia initiatives coordinator; and
- 27 (B) the actions taken by the colonia initiatives

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- 1 coordinator to address the recommendations;
- 2 (2) outline a long-range plan to improve the quality
- 3 of life of colonia residents and propose legislation to implement
- 4 the plan; and
- 5 (3) recommend appropriate programs, grants, and
- 6 activities to address the needs of colonia residents.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
