1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to erecting an off-premise sign adjacent to and visible
1-9 from certain roads.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 391.252, Transportation
1-12 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (a) A [~~Subsequent to the effective date of this subchapter,~~
1-14 ~~a]~~ person may not erect an off-premise sign that is adjacent to and
1-15 visible from:

1-16 (1) U.S. Highway 290 between the western city limits
1-17 of the city of Austin and the eastern city limits of the city of
1-18 Fredericksburg;

1-19 (2) State Highway 317 between the northern city limits
1-20 of the city of Belton to the southern city limits of the city of
1-21 Valley Mills;

1-22 (3) State Highway 16 between the northern city limits
1-23 of the city of Kerrville and Interstate Highway 20;

1-24 (4) U.S. Highway 77 between State Highway 186 and
1-25 State Highway 44;

1-26 (5) U.S. Highway 281 between State Highway 186 and
1-27 Interstate Highway 37;

1-28 (6) State Highway 17 between State Highway 118 and
1-29 U.S. Highway 90;

1-30 (7) State Highway 67 between U.S. Highway 90 and
1-31 Farm-to-Market Road 170;

1-32 (8) Farm-to-Market Road 170 between State Highway 67
1-33 and State Highway 118;

1-34 (9) State Highway 118 between Farm-to-Market Road 170
1-35 and State Highway 17;

1-36 (10) State Highway 105 between the western city limits
1-37 of the city of Sour Lake to the eastern city limits of the city of
1-38 Cleveland;

1-39 (11) State Highway 73 between the eastern city limits
1-40 of the city of Winnie to the western city limits of the city of Port
1-41 Arthur;

1-42 (12) State Highway 21 between the southern city limits
1-43 of the city of College Station and U.S. Highway 290; [~~or~~]

1-44 (13) a highway located in:

1-45 (A) the Sabine National Forest;

1-46 (B) the Davy Crockett National Forest; or

1-47 (C) the Sam Houston National Forest; or

1-48 (14) a highway in Bandera County that is part of the
1-49 state highway system.

1-50 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
