A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT 2 relating to contracts with transit authorities, commercial 3 transportation companies, or juvenile boards.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Education Code, Section 34.008 is amended as 6 follows:

Sec. 34.008. CONTRACT AUTHORITY 7 WITH TRANSIT $\left[\frac{\partial R}{\partial R}\right]$, COMMERCIAL TRANSPORTATION COMPANY OR JUVENILE BOARD. (a) 8 A board of county school trustees or school district board of trustees may 9 10 contract with a mass transit authority, [or] a commercial transportation company, or a juvenile board for all or any part of a 11 12 district's public school transportation if the authority, company 13 or board:

14 (1) requires its school bus drivers to have the 15 qualifications required by and to be certified in accordance with 16 standards established by the Department of Public Safety; and

17 (2) uses only those school buses or mass transit
18 authority buses in transporting 15 or more public school students
19 that meet or exceed safety standards for school buses established
20 under Section 34.002, Education Code.

(b) This section does not prohibit the county or school district board from supplementing the state transportation cost allotment with local funds necessary to provide complete transportation services.

1 (c) A mass transit authority contracting under this section 2 for daily transportation of pre-primary, primary, or secondary 3 students to or from school shall conduct, in a manner and on a 4 schedule approved by the county or district school board, the 5 following education programs:

6 (1) a program to inform the public that public school
7 students will be riding on the authority's or company's buses;

8 (2) a program to educate the drivers of the buses to be 9 used under the contract of the special needs and problems of public 10 school students riding on the buses; and

11 (3) a program to educate public school students on bus 12 riding safety and any special considerations arising from the use 13 of the authority's or company's buses.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
