1-8 relating to appointments to the Tobacco Settlement Permanent Trust
1-9 Account Investment Advisory Committee.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Subsection (b), Section 403.1042, Government
1-12 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-13 (b) The advisory committee is composed of 11 members
1-14 appointed as follows:

1-15 (1) one member appointed by the comptroller to
1-16 represent a public hospital or hospital district located in a
1-17 county with a population of 50,000 or less or a public hospital
1-18 owned or maintained by a municipality;

1-19 (2) one member appointed by the political subdivision
1-20 that, in the year preceding the appointment, received the largest
1-21 annual distribution paid from the account;

1-22 (3) one member appointed by the political subdivision
1-23 that, in the year preceding the appointment, received the second
1-24 largest annual distribution paid from the account;

1-25 (4) four members appointed by the Texas Conference of
1-26 Urban Counties, which shall receive nominations from political
1-27 subdivisions that, [+]

1-28 [~~(A)~~] in the year preceding the appointment,
1-29 received the 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th
1-30 largest annual distribution paid from the account [~~, and~~

1-31 [~~(B) do not have an appointee serving on the~~
1-32 ~~advisory committee at the time of appointment~~];

1-33 (5) one member appointed by the County Judges and
1-34 Commissioners Association of Texas;

1-35 (6) one member appointed by the North and East Texas
1-36 County Judges and Commissioners Association;

1-37 (7) one member appointed by the South Texas County
1-38 Judges and Commissioners Association; and

1-39 (8) one member appointed by the West Texas County
1-40 Judges and Commissioners Association.

1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
