- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 522.042(a), Transportation Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The department may issue a commercial driver's license
- 9 with endorsements:
- 10 (1) authorizing the driving of a vehicle transporting
- 11 hazardous materials, subject to the requirements of Title 49 C.F.R.
- 12 <u>Part 1572</u>;
- 13 (2) authorizing the towing of a double or triple
- 14 trailer or a trailer over a specified weight;
- 15 (3) authorizing the driving of a vehicle carrying
- 16 passengers;
- 17 (4) authorizing the driving of a tank vehicle;
- 18 (5) representing a combination of hazardous materials
- 19 and tank vehicle endorsements; or
- 20 (6) authorizing the driving of a school bus, as
- 21 defined by Section 541.201.
- SECTION 2. Sections 522.051(a)-(d), Transportation Code,
- 23 are amended to read as follows:
- 24 (a) Except as provided by Section 522.033, an original

- 3 (b) A commercial driver's license or commercial driver
- 4 learner's permit issued to a person holding a Texas Class A, B, C,

- 7 learner's permit expires  $\underline{\text{five}}$  [ $\underline{\text{six}}$ ] years after the applicant's

- 9 (c) A commercial driver's license or commercial driver
- 10 learner's permit issued to a person holding a Texas Class A, B, C,
- or M license that would expire less than one year after the date of
- 12 issuance of the commercial driver's license or commercial driver
- 13 learner's permit or that has been expired for less than one year
- 14 expires five [six] years after the expiration date shown on the
- 15 Class A, B, C, or M license.
- 16 (d) A commercial driver's license or commercial driver
- 17 learner's permit issued to a person holding a Texas Class A, B, C,
- or M license that has been expired for at least one year but not more
- 19 than two years expires five [six] years after the applicant's last
- 20 birthday.
- 21 SECTION 3. Section 522.052(b), Transportation Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- 23 (b) A renewal of a commercial driver's license that has been
- 24 expired for less than one year expires five [six] years after the
- 25 expiration date shown on the commercial driver's license.
- SECTION 4. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 27 only to a commercial driver's license or commercial driver

- 1 learner's permit that is issued or renewed on or after the effective
- 2 date of this Act.
- 3 (b) A commercial driver's license or commercial driver
- 4 learner's permit that was issued or renewed before the effective
- 5 date of this Act, is covered by the law in effect immediately before
- 6 the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 7 effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
