A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the Ector County Hospital District. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 4.07, Chapter 550, Acts of the 71st 4 Legislature, Regular Session, 1989, is amended to read as follows: 5 Sec. 4.07. BOND; INSURANCE. (a) Before assuming the duties 6 of the office, each director must execute a bond [for \$5,000] 7 payable to the district or purchase an appropriate insurance policy 8 that names the district as its sole beneficiary, conditioned on the 9 faithful performance of the person's duties as director. For each 10 11 director, the board shall determine the appropriate type and value 12 of the bond or insurance policy required under this section. (b) The bond or insurance policy shall be kept in the 13 14 permanent records of the district. The board may pay for directors' bonds and insurance 15 (c) policies and premiums with district funds. 16 SECTION 2. Section 5.07, Chapter 550, Acts of the 71st 17 Legislature, Regular Session, 1989, is amended to read as follows: 18 Sec. 5.07. CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS. (a) The board may enter 19 into construction contracts on behalf of the district; however, the 20 21 board may enter into construction contracts that involve spending 22 more than the amount provided by Section 271.024, Local Government 23 Code, [\$10,000] only after competitive bidding as provided by Subchapter B, Chapter 271, Local Government Code. 24 79R1178 KEG-F 1

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(b) <u>Chapter 2253, Government Code</u> [Article 5160, Revised
 Statutes], as it relates to performance and payment bonds, applies
 to construction contracts let by the district.

4 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 5.15, Chapter 550, Acts of 5 the 71st Legislature, Regular Session, 1989, is amended to read as 6 follows:

Sec. 5.15. AUTHORITY TO SUE AND BE SUED; VENUE; NON-WAIVER
OF IMMUNITY.

9 SECTION 4. Section 5.15, Chapter 550, Acts of the 71st 10 Legislature, Regular Session, 1989, is amended by adding Subsection 11 (c) to read as follows:

12 (c) Nothing in this Act may be construed to waive sovereign 13 or governmental immunity.

14 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
