11	Sec. 411.084. EDUCATIONAL PUBLICATIONS. (a) The division
12	shall provide educational material, including books, pamphlets,
13	brochures, films, videotapes, or other informational material.
14	(b) Educational material shall be provided to employees in
15	English and Spanish.
16	(c) The commission shall adopt minimum content requirements
17	of the educational material required under this section, including:
18	(1) an employee's right to report an unsafe working
19	<pre>environment;</pre>
20	(2) instructions on how to report unsafe working
21	conditions and safety violations; and
22	(3) state laws regarding retaliation by employers.
23	SECTION 3. The Texas Workers' Compensation Commission shall
24	adopt rules required by Subsection (c), Section 411.084, Labor
