- 2 relating to projects that may be undertaken by or supported by the

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subdivision (11), Section 2, Development
- 6 Corporation Act of 1979 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas Civil
- 7 Statutes), is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (11) $\left[\frac{A}{A}\right]$ "Project" shall mean:
- 9 (A) the land, buildings, equipment, facilities,
- 10 expenditures, targeted infrastructure, and improvements (one or
- 11 more) that are for the creation or retention of primary jobs and
- that are found by the board of directors to be required or suitable
- 13 for the development, retention, or expansion of manufacturing and
- 14 industrial facilities, research and development facilities,
- transportation facilities (including but not limited to airports,
- 16 ports, mass commuting facilities, and parking facilities), sewage
- 17 or solid waste disposal facilities, recycling facilities, air or
- 18 water pollution control facilities, facilities for the furnishing
- 19 of water to the general public, distribution centers, small
- 20 warehouse facilities capable of serving as decentralized storage
- 21 and distribution centers, primary job training facilities for use
- 22 by institutions of higher education, and regional or national
- 23 corporate headquarters facilities; [-]
- 24 (B) ["Project" also includes] job training

- 1 required or suitable for the promotion of development and expansion
- 2 of business enterprises and other enterprises described by this
- Act, as provided by Section 38 of this Act; or [-]
- 4 (C) ["Project" also includes] expenditures found
- 5 by the board of directors to be required or suitable for
- 6 infrastructure necessary to promote or develop new or expanded
- 7 business enterprises limited to streets and roads, rail spurs,
- 8 water and sewer utilities, electric utilities, gas utilities,
- 9 drainage, elevation, and related improvements, [and]
- 10 telecommunications and Internet improvements, and sidewalks.
- 11 SECTION 2. Subdivision (2), Subsection (a), Section 4B,
- 12 Development Corporation Act of 1979 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas
- 13 Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:
- 14 (2) "Project" means land, buildings, equipment,
- 15 facilities, expenditures, and improvements included in the
- 16 definition of that term under Section 2 of this Act, and includes
- job training as provided by Section 38 of this Act. For purposes of
- 18 this section, the term includes recycling facilities, and land,
- 19 buildings, equipment, facilities, and improvements found by the
- 20 board of directors to:
- 21 (A) be required or suitable for use for
- 22 professional and amateur (including children's) sports, athletic,
- 23 entertainment, tourist, convention, and public park purposes and
- 24 events, including stadiums, ball parks, auditoriums,
- 25 amphitheaters, concert halls, parks and park facilities, open space
- 26 improvements, museums, exhibition facilities, and related store,
- 27 restaurant, concession, and automobile parking facilities, related

- 1 area transportation facilities, and related roads, streets, and
- 2 water and sewer facilities, and other related improvements that
- 3 enhance any of those items;
- 4 (B) promote or develop new or expanded business
- 5 enterprises that create or retain primary jobs, including a project
- 6 to provide public safety facilities, streets and roads, drainage
- 7 and related improvements, demolition of existing structures,
- 8 general municipally owned improvements, as well as any improvements
- 9 or facilities that are related to any of those projects and any
- 10 other project that the board in its discretion determines promotes
- 11 or develops new or expanded business enterprises that create or
- 12 retain primary jobs;
- 13 (C) be required or suitable for the promotion of
- 14 development and expansion of affordable housing, as defined by 42
- 15 U.S.C. Section 12745;
- 16 (D) be required or suitable for the development
- 17 or improvement of water supply facilities, including dams,
- transmission lines, well field developments, and other water supply
- 19 alternatives; [or]
- 20 (E) be required or suitable for the development
- 21 and institution of water conservation programs, including
- 22 incentives to install water-saving plumbing fixtures, educational
- 23 programs, brush control programs, and programs to replace
- 24 malfunctioning or leaking water lines and other water facilities;

- 26 (F) be required or suitable for the promotion of
- 27 new or expanded business development if the project is undertaken

- 1 by a corporation created by an eligible city that in the preceding
- 2 three years has received an average of less than \$400,000 from taxes
- 3 imposed under this section.
- 4 SECTION 3. Section 4B, Development Corporation Act of 1979
- 5 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (g-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (g-1)(1) This subsection applies only to a corporation
- 8 <u>created by an eligible city that in the preceding three years has</u>
- 9 received an average of \$100,000 or more and less than \$400,000 from
- 10 taxes imposed under this section.
- 11 (2) A corporation to which this subsection applies may
- not use more than 35 percent of the corporation's tax proceeds for a
- project described by Subsection (a)(2)(F) of this section.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
