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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to projects that may be undertaken by or supported by the 3 tax proceeds of certain development corporations. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 2(11), Development Corporation Act of 5 6 1979 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows: 7 (11) [(A)] "Project" shall mean: 8 9 (A) the land, buildings, equipment, facilities, expenditures, targeted infrastructure, and improvements (one or 10 11 more) that are for the creation or retention of primary jobs and 12 that are found by the board of directors to be required or suitable for the development, retention, or expansion of manufacturing and 13 14 industrial facilities, research and development facilities, transportation facilities (including but not limited to airports, 15 ports, mass commuting facilities, and parking facilities), sewage 16 or solid waste disposal facilities, recycling facilities, air or 17 water pollution control facilities, facilities for the furnishing 18 of water to the general public, distribution centers, small 19 warehouse facilities capable of serving as decentralized storage 20 21 and distribution centers, primary job training facilities for use by institutions of higher education, and regional or national 22 corporate headquarters facilities;[+] 23 (B) ["Project" also includes] 24 job training

1 required or suitable for the promotion of development and expansion
2 of business enterprises and other enterprises described by this
3 Act, as provided by Section 38 of this Act; or [-]

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["Project" also includes] expenditures found 4 (C) 5 by the board of directors to be required or suitable for infrastructure necessary to promote or develop new or expanded 6 business enterprises limited to streets and roads, rail spurs, 7 8 water and sewer utilities, electric utilities, gas utilities, drainage, elevation, and related improvements, 9 [and] 10 telecommunications and Internet improvements, sidewalks, and 11 building facades.

SECTION 2. Section 4B(a)(2), Development Corporation Act of 13 1979 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to 14 read as follows:

(2) 15 "Project" means land, buildings, equipment, facilities, expenditures, and improvements included in the 16 definition of that term under Section 2 of this Act, and includes 17 job training as provided by Section 38 of this Act. For purposes of 18 19 this section, the term includes recycling facilities, and land, buildings, equipment, facilities, and improvements found by the 20 board of directors to: 21

required suitable for for 22 (A) be or use professional and amateur (including children's) sports, athletic, 23 24 entertainment, tourist, convention, and public park purposes and including stadiums, ball 25 events, parks, auditoriums, 26 amphitheaters, concert halls, parks and park facilities, open space improvements, museums, exhibition facilities, and related store, 27

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1 restaurant, concession, and automobile parking facilities, related 2 area transportation facilities, and related roads, streets, and 3 water and sewer facilities, and other related improvements that 4 enhance any of those items;

5 (B) promote or develop new or expanded business 6 enterprises that create or retain primary jobs, including a project 7 to provide public safety facilities, streets and roads, drainage and related improvements, demolition of existing structures, 8 general municipally owned improvements, as well as any improvements 9 or facilities that are related to any of those projects and any 10 other project that the board in its discretion determines promotes 11 12 or develops new or expanded business enterprises that create or retain primary jobs; 13

14 (C) be required or suitable for the promotion of 15 development and expansion of affordable housing, as defined by 42 16 U.S.C. Section 12745;

(D) be required or suitable for the development or improvement of water supply facilities, including dams, transmission lines, well field developments, and other water supply alternatives; [or]

21 (E) be required or suitable for the development institution of water conservation programs, 22 and including incentives to install water-saving plumbing fixtures, educational 23 24 programs, brush control programs, and programs to replace malfunctioning or leaking water lines and other water facilities; 25 26 or

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(F) be required or suitable for the development

or expansion of business enterprises that create or retain jobs 1 2 included in North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) sector number 44-45, Retail Trade, 561591, Convention and Visitors 3 4 Bureaus, or 62, Health Care and Social Assistance, if the project is 5 undertaken by a corporation created by an eligible city: 6 (i) that in the preceding three years has 7 received an average of less than \$500,000 from taxes imposed under 8 this section; or 9 (ii) that has a population of 50,000 or 10 less. SECTION 3. Section 4B, Development Corporation Act of 1979 11 (Article 5190.6, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended by 12 adding Subsection (g-1) to read as follows: 13 14 (q-1)(1) This subsection applies only to a corporation 15 created by an eligible city: 16 (A) that in the preceding three years has 17 received an average of less than \$500,000 from taxes imposed under this section; or 18 (B) that has a population of 50,000 or less. 19 20 (2) A corporation to which this subsection applies may 21 not use more than 50 percent of the corporation's tax proceeds for a project other than a project described by Section 2(11) of this Act. 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 23

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
