S.B. No. 1339

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the limitation on the sales and use tax rate of a 3 political subdivision in an advanced transportation district. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 451.706, Transportation Code, is amended 5 6 by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows: 7 Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), if [If] after an 8 (b) 9 election held under this subchapter the imposition of the district's tax in a participating unit would exceed the limit 10 imposed under Subsection (a), the election of a participating unit 11 12 to join the district repeals all other local sales and use taxes in that unit, except for: 13 14 (1) the sales and use tax of the authority; [and] a sales and use tax of not more than one percent 15 (2) imposed by a municipality under Section 321.101(a) or 321.103(a), 16 Tax Code; or 17 (3) a sales and use tax, or the dedicated portion of a 18 sales and use tax, that is imposed to pay the principal of and 19 interest on a debt of the participating unit. 20 21 (b-1) If after repealing all other local sales and use taxes under Subsection (b) the imposition of the district's tax would 22 23 still cause the tax rate in the participating unit to exceed the limitation imposed under Subsection (a), the unit does not become 24

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part of the district until the rate imposed in the unit does not 1 2 exceed the limitation. A sales and use tax or dedicated portion of a tax imposed in the unit that is described by Subsection (b)(3) is 3 4 repealed on retirement of the debt for which the tax or portion was 5 imposed. 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a political subdivision that participates in or that holds an 7 8 election to join an advanced transportation district on or after the effective date of this Act. 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 14

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
