S.B. No. 1348

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to records and reports kept and produced by the Texas
3 Workforce Commission civil rights division.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subsection (e), Section 21.010, Labor Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (e) Each state agency shall require an employee of the
8 agency who attends a training program required by this section to
9 sign a statement verifying the employee's attendance at the
10 training program. The agency shall file the statement in the
11 employee's personnel file. Web-based training records may be kept
12 electronically.

13 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 21.552, Labor Code, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 (a) Not later than November 1 [~~the seventh day~~] of each
16 [~~calendar~~] year [~~, excluding legal holidays and weekends~~], each
17 state agency shall report equal employment opportunity information
18 for the preceding fiscal [~~calendar~~] year to the commission as
19 required by this subchapter. The report must be made in the form
20 prescribed by the commission and include information compiled on a
21 monthly basis.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
