7	Sec. 51.002. SUPER MAJORITY PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN
8	CIRCUMSTANCES. (a) A municipality may not require the approval of
9	more than a simple majority of the governing body of the
10	municipality to:
11	(1) adopt or amend an ordinance or resolution
12	authorized under:
13	(A) Section 401.002; or
14	(B) Section 26.177, Water Code;
15	(2) execute an agreement under Section 212.172; or
16	(3) compromise and settle an action with a property
17	owner authorized under Section 245.006.
18	(b) A municipal ordinance or charter provision is void to
19	the extent it violates Subsection (a).
20	(c) The act of a municipality described by Subsections
21	(a)(1)-(3) taken before September 1, 2005, with the approval of a
22	simple majority, is valid unless the act has been determined
23	invalid by a final judgment of a court that is not subject to

appeal.
