2	relating to prohibiting semiautomatic assault weapons; creating an
3	offense.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 46.01, Penal Code, is amended by adding
6	Subdivision (17) to read as follows:
7	(17) "Semiautomatic assault weapon" means:
8	(A) a semiautomatic rifle that has the capacity
9	to accept a detachable magazine and has at least two of the
10	following:
11	(i) a pistol grip that protrudes
12	conspicuously beneath the action of the weapon;
13	(ii) a folding or telescoping stock;
14	(iii) a grenade launcher or flare launcher;
15	(iv) a flash suppressor or threaded barrel
16	designed to accommodate a flash suppressor;
17	(v) a forward pistol grip; or
18	(vi) a bayonet mount;
19	(B) a semiautomatic pistol that has the capacity
20	to accept a detachable magazine and has at least two of the
21	following:
22	(i) an ammunition magazine that attaches to
23	the pistol outside of the pistol grip;
24	(ii) a threaded barrel, capable of

1	accepting a barrel extender, flash suppressor, forward handgrip, or
2	<pre>silencer;</pre>
3	(iii) a shroud that is attached to, or
4	partially or completely encircles, the barrel and that allows the
5	bearer to fire the weapon without burning the bearer's hand, except
6	a slide that encloses the barrel;
7	(iv) a manufactured weight of 50 ounces or
8	more when the pistol is unloaded; or
9	(v) a semiautomatic version of an automatic
10	<pre>firearm;</pre>
11	(C) a semiautomatic shotgun that has at least two
12	of the following:
13	(i) a folding or telescoping stock;
14	(ii) a pistol grip that protrudes
15	conspicuously beneath the action of the weapon;
16	(iii) a fixed magazine capacity in excess
17	of five rounds; or
18	(iv) the capacity to accept a detachable
19	magazine;
20	(D) a shotgun with a revolving cylinder; and
21	(E) any of the following firearms, or a copy or
22	duplicate of any of the following firearms, in any caliber:
23	(i) Norinco, Mitchell, or Poly Technologies
24	Avtomat Kalashnikovs (all models);
25	(ii) Action Arms Israeli Military
26	<pre>Industries UZI and Galil;</pre>
27	(iii) Beretta AR-70;

1	(iv) Colt AR-15;
2	(v) Fabrique National FN/FAL, FN/LAR, and
3	FNC;
4	(vi) SWD M-10, M-11, M-11/9, and M-12;
5	(vii) Steyr AUG; or
6	(viii) INTRATEC TEC-9, TEC-DC9, and TEC-22.
7	SECTION 2. Chapter 46, Penal Code, is amended by adding
8	Section 46.055 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 46.055. SEMIAUTOMATIC ASSAULT WEAPONS PROHIBITED. (a)
10	A person commits an offense if the person knowingly possesses,
11	manufactures, transports, repairs, sells, or offers to sell a
12	semiautomatic assault weapon.
13	(b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor,
14	except that if it is shown on the trial of the offense that the
15	person has been previously convicted of an offense under this
16	section, the offense is a state jail felony.
17	(c) It is a defense to prosecution under this section that:
18	(1) the semiautomatic assault weapon is a firearm
19	manufactured before Janurary 1, 1899;
20	(2) the person lawfully possessed the weapon on August
21	<u>31, 2005;</u>
22	(3) the person's conduct was incidental to the
23	performance of an official duty by the armed forces or national
24	guard, a governmental law enforcement agency, or a correctional
25	<pre>facility; or</pre>
26	(4) the weapon is one sanctioned by the International
27	Olympic Committee and by USA Shooting and is used solely for

- 1 <u>competitive target shooting purposes.</u>
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
