- 2 relating to a limitation on increases in the total amount of tuition
- 3 and compulsory fees charged by public institutions of higher

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 54.011 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 54.011. LIMITATION ON INCREASE IN TOTAL AMOUNT OF
- 9 TUITION AND COMPULSORY FEES. (a) In this section, "compulsory fee"
- 10 has the meaning assigned by Section 54.503.
- 11 (b) The total amount of tuition and compulsory fees charged
- by an institution of higher education to a student may not exceed
- 13 the total amount of tuition and compulsory fees that the
- 14 institution would have charged to a similarly situated student in
- 15 the preceding academic year by more than five percent. For purposes
- of this subsection, students are similarly situated if they share
- 17 the same residency status, degree program, course load, course
- 18 level, tuition exemption status, and other circumstances affecting
- 19 the tuition and compulsory fees charged to the student. This
- 20 <u>subsection does not ensure that the total amount of tuition and</u>
- 21 compulsory fees charged to an individual student does not increase
- 22 by more than five percent based on a change in the student's
- 23 residency status, degree program, course load, course level,
- 24 tuition exemption status, or other circumstance affecting the

- 1 <u>tuition and compulsory fees charged to the student.</u>
- 2 (c) If as a result of a required statutory increase in
- 3 tuition or a compulsory fee an institution of higher education
- 4 would charge more in tuition and compulsory fees for an academic
- 5 period than permitted under Subsection (b) because the institution
- 6 does not have sufficient time before the beginning of the academic
- 7 period to adjust its tuition and compulsory fee charges:
- 8 (1) tuition for which rates are prescribed under
- 9 Section 54.051 or another provision prescribing tuition rates shall
- 10 <u>be charged at those required rates; and</u>
- 11 (2) the amount designated as tuition under Section
- 12 54.0513 or another provision authorizing an institution to
- 13 establish tuition rates, and the amount of a compulsory fee that is
- 14 not prescribed by law, must each be reduced by the same percentage
- 15 as necessary to comply with Subsection (b), except that the
- 16 institution is not required to reduce a fee that is approved by a
- 17 majority vote of the institution's students participating in a
- 18 general student election held for that purpose.
- 19 (d) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board may adopt
- 20 rules as necessary to administer this section.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the total amount
- 22 of tuition and compulsory fees charged by public institutions of
- 23 higher education for the 2005-2006 academic year.
- 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
