## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the transfer of alcoholic beverages.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Section 26.08 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 26.08. TRANSFER OF BEVERAGES. The owner of more than
- one Wine and Beer Retailer's Off-Premise Permits who is also the
- 8 holder of a local cartage permit may transfer alcoholic beverages
- 9 within the manner described in Section 22.08 of this Code and time
- 10 periods described in Section 105.051 of this Code, subject to rules
- 11 prescribed by the commission.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 43, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended
- by adding Section 43.01(c) to read as follows:
- 14 (c) A wine and beer retailer's off-premise permit holder who
- 15 also holds a local cartage permit may transfer alcoholic beverages
- 16 it is authorized to sell in accordance with Section 26.08 of this
- 17 code.
- 18 SECTION 3. Section 43.04, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 19 amended to read as follows:
- The Commission may issue a local cartage permit to a
- 21 warehouse or transfer company or to a holder of a package store,
- 22 wine only package store, wine and beer retailer's off-premise
- 23 permit, or local distributor's permit.
- SECTION 4. Section 43.05, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is

- 1 amended to read as follows:
- 2 (a) No local cartage permittee may transport alcoholic
- 3 beverages [liquor] unless:
- 4 (1) a description of each vehicle used in the
- 5 transportation, as required by the commission, has been submitted
- 6 to the commission; and
- 7 (2) each vehicle has been plainly marked or lettered
- 8 to indicate that it is being used for the transportation of
- 9 alcoholic beverages [liquor] by a local cartage permittee.
- 10 (b) The transportation of <u>alcoholic beverages</u> [<del>liquor</del>] by a
- 11 permittee in a vehicle not described and marked in accordance with
- 12 this section is a violation of this code and is a ground for the
- 13 cancellation of the permit.
- 14 SECTION 5. Section 43.06, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- No holder of a local cartage permit may for hire transport
- 17 alcoholic beverages [liquor] between incorporated cities or towns
- 18 in this state.
- 19 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
