A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to eligibility for beginning positions in certain police 3 and fire departments. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 143, Section 143.025, 5 6 Local Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (j) to read 7 as follows: (j) Notwithstanding Subsection (i), each applicant who is 8 either a natural-born or adopted child of a fire fighter who 9 previously suffered a line-of-duty death while covered by this 10 chapter shall be ranked at the top of any eligibility list in which 11 said applicant receives a minimum passing grade on that respective 12 13 eligibility exam. The deceased fire fighter's applicant child must otherwise satisfy all of the requirements for eligibility for a 14 beginning position in a fire department contained in this chapter. 15 This commission shall promulgate rules to identify and verify each 16 applicant's eligibility for applicability of this subsection. 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
