Section 6A(d), Article 21.49, Insurance Code, is 5 amended to read as follows: 6 A windstorm inspection may only be performed by a 7 (d) qualified inspector. For purposes of this article, a "qualified 8 inspector" includes: 9 (1) a person determined by the department to be 10 11 qualified to perform building inspections because of training or 12 experience; 13 (2) a licensed professional engineer meeting the 14 requirements of the rules adopted by the commissioner for 15 appointment to conduct windstorm inspections; and (3) an inspector who is certified by the International 16 Code Council or the International Association of Plumbing and 17 Mechanical Officials [, the Building Officials and Code 18 Administrators International, Inc., the International Conference 19 of Building Officials, or the Southern Building Code Congress 20 International, Inc., ] who has certifications as a buildings 21 inspector, plumbing inspector, or mechanical inspector and as a 22 23 coastal construction inspector, and who also complies with other requirements specified by rule by the commissioner. inspector must be approved and appointed or employed by the department to perform building inspections. The department may charge a reasonable fee for the filing of applications and determining the qualifications of persons for appointment as gualified inspectors.
SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
