A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the discharge of teachers for good cause under a 3 probationary contract in a public school. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 21.104(a), Education Code, is amended to 5 6 read as follows: (a) A teacher employed under a probationary contract may be 7 discharged at any time for good cause as determined by the board of 8 trustees, good cause being the failure to meet the generally 9 accepted standards of conduct for the profession [as generally 10 recognized and applied in similarly situated school districts in 11 12 this state]. SECTION 2. Section 21.104(a), Education Code, as amended by 13 14 this Act, applies only to a discharge under a probation contract for which written notice of the proposed discharge is given to a teacher 15 on or after September 1, 2005. A discharge under a probation 16 contract for which written notice of the proposed discharge is 17 given to a teacher before September 1, 2005, is governed by the law 18 in effect when the notice is given, and the former law is continued 19 in effect for that purpose. 20 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
