A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the administration and operation of the Fleet Admiral
- 3 Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 22.231, 22.232, and 22.233, Parks and
- 6 Wildlife Code, are transferred to Chapter 442, Government Code,
- 7 redesignated as Sections 442.019 and 442.020, Government Code, and
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 442.019 [22.231]. FLEET ADMIRAL CHESTER W. NIMITZ
- 10 MEMORIAL NAVAL MUSEUM [JURISDICTION]. (a) The Fleet Admiral
- 11 Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum is under the jurisdiction
- of the commission [department].
- (b) [Sec. 22.232. POWERS OF DEPARTMENT.] With respect to
- 14 the Nimitz museum and in addition to its other powers and duties,
- 15 the commission [department]:
- 16 (1) shall foster and commemorate the memory of the era
- of supreme United States naval power upon the seas and the men and
- 18 women of the armed services whose gallant and selfless dedication
- 19 to duty made this era possible;
- 20 (2) shall administer the Fleet Admiral Chester W.
- 21 Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum at Fredericksburg;
- 22 (3) shall act in any other capacity relative to
- 23 preserving naval documents, relics, and other items of historical
- 24 interest;

- 1 (4) may employ and discharge a museum director and
- 2 other employees it deems necessary to fulfill its duties and
- 3 responsibilities within the limits of funds available;
- 4 (5) may accept on behalf of the State of Texas
- 5 donations of money, property, and historical relics related to the
- 6 museum's theme; and
- 7 (6) may acquire property and historical relics by
- 8 purchase within the limits of funds available.
- 9 Sec. 442.020 [22.233]. REVENUE BONDS FOR NIMITZ MUSEUM.
- 10 (a) The commission [department], by resolution [of the
- 11 commission], may request the Texas Public Finance Authority to
- 12 issue revenue bonds or other revenue obligations to finance the
- 13 repair, renovation, improvement, expansion, and equipping of the
- 14 Nimitz museum for one or more projects not to exceed an aggregated
- 15 estimated cost of \$9 million.
- (b) On receipt of a request by the commission [department]
- 17 under this section for the issuance of revenue bonds or other
- 18 revenue obligations, the Texas Public Finance Authority shall
- 19 promptly issue the bonds or other revenue obligations under and in
- 20 accordance with Chapter 1232[Government Code].
- 21 (c) The <u>commission</u> [<u>department</u>] shall deposit the proceeds
- 22 of revenue bonds or other revenue obligations issued under this
- 23 section to the credit of the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz
- 24 Memorial Naval Museum account. The account is a separate account in
- 25 the general revenue fund that is composed of money deposited to the
- 26 credit of the account under this section or Section 442.019. The
- 27 <u>commission may use money in the account</u> [Texas parks and wildlife

- 1 conservation and capital account and may use the proceeds] only to
- 2 finance the repair, renovation, improvement, expansion, and
- 3 equipping of the museum.
- 4 (d) Notwithstanding any other law, the commission
- 5 [department] may contract with the Admiral Nimitz Foundation for
- 6 the renovation, improvement, or expansion of the museum.
- 7 (e) The <u>commission</u> [<u>department</u>] may accept contributions
- 8 from the Admiral Nimitz Foundation and other sources in connection
- 9 with the repair, renovation, improvement, expansion, equipping, or
- 10 operation of the museum.
- 11 SECTION 2. The subchapter heading to Subchapter Q, Chapter
- 12 22, Parks and Wildlife Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 3. (a) On the date specified by the Parks and
- 14 Wildlife Department and the Texas Historical Commission in a
- 15 memorandum of understanding entered into under Section 4 of this
- 16 Act:
- 17 (1) the Texas Historical Commission replaces the Parks
- 18 and Wildlife Department as the administrator of the Fleet Admiral
- 19 Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum;
- 20 (2) all functions and activities performed by the
- 21 Parks and Wildlife Department that relate to the administration and
- 22 operation of the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval
- 23 Museum immediately before that date are transferred to the Texas
- 24 Historical Commission;
- 25 (3) a rule or form adopted by the Parks and Wildlife
- 26 Department that relates to the administration and operation of the
- 27 Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum is a rule or

- 1 form of the Texas Historical Commission and remains in effect until
- changed by the commission;
- 3 (4) a reference in law to the Parks and Wildlife
- 4 Department that relates to the administration and operation of the
- 5 Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum means the
- 6 Texas Historical Commission;
- 7 (5) a contract negotiation or other proceeding
- 8 involving the Parks and Wildlife Department that is related to the
- 9 administration and operation of the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz
- 10 Memorial Naval Museum is transferred without change in status to
- 11 the Texas Historical Commission, and the commission assumes,
- 12 without a change in status, the position of the Parks and Wildlife
- 13 Department in a negotiation or proceeding relating to the
- 14 administration and operation of the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz
- 15 Memorial Naval Museum;
- 16 (6) all money, contracts, leases, rights, and
- 17 obligations of the Parks and Wildlife Department related to the
- administration and operation of the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz
- 19 Memorial Naval Museum are transferred to the Texas Historical
- 20 Commission;
- 21 (7) the proceeds of any bonds or other obligations
- 22 related to the repair, renovation, or other improvement to the
- 23 Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum deposited to
- 24 the credit of the Texas parks and wildlife conservation and capital
- 25 account are transferred to the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz
- 26 Memorial Naval Museum account under Section 442.020, Government
- 27 Code, as added by this Act, to be used by the Texas Historical

- 1 Commission in accordance with that section;
- 2 (8) all real and personal property in the custody of
- 3 the Parks and Wildlife Department related to the administration and
- 4 operation of the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval
- 5 Museum, including administrative records and naval documents,
- 6 relics, and other items of historical interest acquired by the
- 7 department in relation to the museum, becomes property in the
- 8 custody of the Texas Historical Commission, but stays in the same
- 9 physical location unless moved in accordance with the memorandum
- 10 entered into under Section 4 of this Act; and
- 11 (9) all funds appropriated by the legislature to the
- 12 Parks and Wildlife Department for purposes related to the
- 13 administration and operation of the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz
- 14 Memorial Naval Museum, including funds for providing
- 15 administrative support for those services such as funds to pay the
- 16 salary and benefits of employees who provide the administrative
- 17 support, are transferred to the Texas Historical Commission.
- 18 (b) If no date is specified for a transfer under Subsection
- 19 (a) of this section in a memorandum of understanding entered into
- 20 under Section 4 of this Act, the transfer takes place on December 1,
- 21 2009.
- 22 SECTION 4. (a) As soon as possible after the effective date
- of this section, but not later than December 1, 2009, the Parks and
- 24 Wildlife Department and the Texas Historical Commission shall enter
- 25 into a memorandum of understanding to implement the transfer
- 26 described in Section 3 of this Act. The memorandum:
- 27 (1) may require the Parks and Wildlife Department to

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- 1 provide funding to the Texas Historical Commission in relation to
- 2 an agreement under the memorandum for the operation of the Fleet
- 3 Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum; and
- 4 (2) shall specify:
- 5 (A) the date that the transfer under Section 3 of
- 6 this Act takes place;
- 7 (B) a timetable for any necessary or advisable
- 8 movement of the physical location of property, including records;
- 9 (C) an inventory of all historical artifacts,
- 10 documents, and other property required to be transferred; and
- 11 (D) provisions for the access of the Texas
- 12 Historical Commission to the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz
- 13 Memorial Naval Museum and any related facilities not later than
- 14 December 1, 2009.
- 15 (b) If the Parks and Wildlife Department and the Texas
- 16 Historical Commission transfer funds relating to the operation of
- 17 the Fleet Admiral Chester W. Nimitz Memorial Naval Museum under a
- 18 memorandum of understanding under this section, the agencies shall,
- 19 in addition, transfer any bonds or other obligations relating to
- 20 the funds.
- 21 SECTION 5. As soon as possible after the Parks and Wildlife
- 22 Department and the Texas Historical Commission enter into a
- 23 memorandum of understanding under Section 4 of this Act that
- 24 specifies the date of the transfer under Section 3 of this Act, the
- 25 agencies shall send the memorandum to the secretary of state for
- 26 publication in the Texas Register.
- 27 SECTION 6. (a) This section and Sections 4 and 5 of this Act

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- 1 take effect September 1, 2005.
- 2 (b) Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this Act take effect in
- 3 accordance with the date specified in the memorandum of
- 4 understanding required by Section 4 of this Act as the date of the
- 5 transfer under Section 3 of this Act.
