1-15	participating in the uniform group coverage program under
1-16	Subsection (a) or providing group health coverage under Subsection
1-17	(b) whose resignation is effective after the last day of an
1-18	instructional year is entitled to participate or be enrolled in the
1-20	uniform group coverage plan or the group health coverage through
1-21	the first anniversary of the date that participation in or coverage
1-22	under the uniform group coverage plan or the group health coverage
