1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to parking by state employees in state-owned garages.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subsection (g), Section 2165.2035, Government
1-13 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-14 (g) Any lease of a state-owned parking lot or garage under
1-15 this section must contain a provision that allows state employees
1-16 who work hours other than regular working hours under Section
1-17 658.005 to retain their parking privileges in a state-owned parking
1-18 lot or garage. Such a lease must also provide that any state
1-19 employee showing a State of Texas employee identification card is
1-20 permitted to park in any state-owned parking lot or garage free of
1-21 charge after normal business hours and on weekends. The foregoing
1-22 provision does not apply to a lease to an institution of higher
1-23 education under which all spaces in a parking lot or garage are
1-24 leased for a time certain if parking in an alternate state-owned
1-25 parking lot or garage is available to state employees.

1-26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-28 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-30 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
