## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating	to	the	regulation	of	certain	rehabilitation	services	for

- 3 injured employees in the workers' compensation system.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 408, Labor Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 408.031 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 408.031. INTERDISCIPLINARY REHABILITATION PROGRAMS
- 8 AND FACILITIES ACCREDITATION. The commission shall adopt a rule
- 9 requiring that an interdisciplinary rehabilitation program or
- 10 facility that provides services to injured employees under this
- 11 chapter be appropriately accredited.

- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to services provided by an interdisciplinary rehabilitation
- 14 program or facility on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 15 Services provided by an interdisciplinary rehabilitation program
- or facility before the effective date of this Act are covered by the
- 17 law in effect when the services were provided, and the former law is
- 18 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. The Texas Workers' Compensation Commission shall
- adopt rules implementing the change in law made by Section 408.031,
- 21 Labor Code, as added by this Act, not later than December 1, 2005.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
