## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a small contractor assistance program for bidding on
3	construction contracts at institutions of higher education.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter T, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 51.785 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 51.785. SMALL CONTRACTOR PARTICIPATION ASSISTANCE
8	PROGRAM. (a) In this section:
9	(1) "Governing board" has the meaning assigned by
10	Section 61.003.
11	(2) "Public works project" means a construction
12	project designed to serve the public necessity, use, or convenience
13	that is undertaken and executed by a governing board, including a
14	project for the construction, alteration, or repair of a public
15	building.
16	(3) "Small contractor" means a contractor that
17	operates as a small-business concern as defined by 15 U.S.C.
18	Section 78c.
19	(4) "University system" has the meaning assigned by
20	Section 61.003.
21	(b) This section applies only to a contract or aggregated
22	contracts for public works projects that have an estimated cost of
23	more than \$20 million.
24	(c) A university system shall maintain a small contractor

1	participation assistance program to ensure full opportunity for
2	participation in public works projects by small contractors. The
3	program must include:
4	(1) a system for the centralized purchase of insurance
5	coverage for public works projects required under Subsection (d);
6	(2) a public outreach plan to:
7	(A) provide public information about the
8	program; and
9	(B) encourage small contractors to participate
10	in the program;
11	(3) a technical assistance plan meeting the
12	requirements of Subsection (e) to aid small contractors in
13	developing the skills necessary to participate in the program; and
14	(4) a financing assistance plan to provide
15	administrative and other assistance to small contractors in
16	obtaining necessary financing arrangements to make the
17	participation of those contractors possible.
18	(d) A university system shall provide for the centralized
19	purchasing under this section of:
20	(1) workers' compensation insurance coverage;
21	(2) employer's liability insurance coverage;
22	(3) commercial general and excess liability coverage;
23	(4) payment and performance bonds; and
24	(5) other similar coverage the governing board
25	considers necessary and reasonable for a public works project.
26	(e) A technical assistance plan adopted by the university
27	system must include information on and assistance concerning:

1	(1) bid estimation, the bidding process, scheduling,
2	and the understanding of bid documents;
3	(2) the reading of construction drawings and other
4	analogous documents;
5	(3) business accounting, bonds, and bond
6	requirements;
7	(4) negotiation with general contractors; and
8	(5) other technical and administrative matters
9	considered appropriate and necessary given the complexity and scope
10	of a public works project.
11	(f) The university system may negotiate contracts with
12	persons or firms having expertise in the areas that must be included
13	in the system's technical assistance plan to provide the
14	information and assistance.
15	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
