| 15 | appointed as provided by Section 7 of this Act. |
| 16 | (b) <u>Each director shall serve at the pleasure of the</u> |

| 18 | (c) Except for the initial term, all directors appointed by |
| 19 | the county commissioners court in each county in the district serve |
| 20 | four-year terms. The director appointed jointly under Subsection |
| 21 | (b), Section 7 of this Act, serves a two-year term. The terms of |
| 22 | four initial directors will expire at the end of the calendar year |

2 (d) [(c)] Subject to Subsection (c) [(b)] of this section,
3 the initial directors appointed by the county commissioners court
4 in each county shall draw lots to determine one initial director
5 from each county who shall serve a two-year term. The other initial
6 directors shall serve terms of four years.

7 (e) [(d)] Each director must qualify to serve as a director
8 in the manner provided by Section 36.055, Water Code.

9 <u>(f)</u> [(e)] A director serves until the director's successor 10 has qualified.

(g) [(f)] Directors may serve consecutive terms.

12 (h) [(g)] If there is a vacancy on the board of directors, 13 the governing body of the entity that appointed the director who 14 vacated the office shall appoint a director to serve the remainder 15 of the term.

16 <u>(i)</u> [(h)] Directors are not entitled to receive 17 compensation for serving as a director but may be reimbursed for 18 actual, reasonable expenses incurred in the discharge of official 19 duties.

20 (j) [(i)] A majority vote of a quorum is required for board
 21 action. If there is a tie vote, the proposed action fails.
