- 5 SECTION 1. Section 5, Chapter 1387, Acts of the 77th
- 6 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended by adding Subsection
- 7 (g) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(g) The district may not assess a fee of any type on a well</u>
- 9 if the well's production is used only for domestic, agricultural,
- 10 or wildlife purposes within the district.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 6, Chapter 1387, Acts of the 77th
- 12 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 6. BOARD OF DIRECTORS. (a) The district is governed
- 14 by a board of directors appointed as provided by Section 7 of this
- 15 Act.
- 16 (b) Each director shall serve at the pleasure of the
- political subdivision by which the appointment was made.
- 18 (c) Except for the initial term, all directors appointed by
- 19 the county commissioners court in each county in the district serve
- 20 four-year terms. The director appointed jointly under Subsection
- 21 (b), Section 7 of this Act, serves a two-year term. The terms of
- 22 four initial directors will expire at the end of the calendar year
- 23 two years after the effective date of this Act and the terms of
- 24 three initial directors will expire at the end of the calendar year

- 1 four years after the effective date of this Act.
- 2 (d) [(c)] Subject to Subsection (c) [(b)] of this section,
- 3 the initial directors appointed by the county commissioners court
- 4 in each county shall draw lots to determine one initial director
- from each county who shall serve a two-year term. The other initial
- 6 directors shall serve terms of four years.
- 7  $\underline{\text{(e)}}$  [ $\frac{\text{(d)}}{\text{)}}$ ] Each director must qualify to serve as a director
- 8 in the manner provided by Section 36.055, Water Code.
- 9 (f) [<del>(e)</del>] A director serves until the director's successor
- 10 has qualified.
- 11  $\underline{(g)}$  [f] Directors may serve consecutive terms.
- 12  $\frac{\text{(h)}}{\text{(g)}}$  If there is a vacancy on the board of directors,
- 13 the governing body of the entity that appointed the director who
- 14 vacated the office shall appoint a director to serve the remainder
- 15 of the term.
- 16 (i) [<del>(h)</del>] Directors are not entitled to receive
- 17 compensation for serving as a director but may be reimbursed for
- 18 actual, reasonable expenses incurred in the discharge of official
- 19 duties.
- 20 (j) [<del>(i)</del>] A majority vote of a quorum is required for board
- 21 action. If there is a tie vote, the proposed action fails.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
