S.B. No. 1621

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the tax rate for emergency services districts located 3 in certain populous counties. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 775.018(a), Health and Safety Code, is 5 6 amended to read as follows: On [Except as provided by Subsection (b), on] the 7 (a) granting of a petition, the commissioners court shall order an 8 election to confirm the district's creation and authorize the 9 imposition of a tax not to exceed the rate allowed by Section 48-e, 10 11 Article III, Texas Constitution. Any conditions negotiated under 12 Section 775.014(h) must be included on the ballot. 13 SECTION 2. Sections 775.018(b), 775.0741, and 775.0745(e), 14 Health and Safety Code, are repealed. SECTION 3. Section 775.018, as amended by this Act, applies 15 only to a petition granted on or after the effective date of this 16 Act. A petition granted before the effective date of this Act is 17 18 governed by the law in effect when the petition was granted, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 19 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act do not affect 20 21 taxes imposed before the effective date of this Act, and the law in 22 effect before the effective date of this Act is continued in effect for purposes of the liability for and collection of those taxes. 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 24

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
