4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 109, Alcoholic Beverage
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 109.36 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 109.36. CERTAIN HOUSE PARTIES. (a) The governing body
8	of a municipality may by ordinance prohibit the gathering of five or
9	more minors in a private dwelling if:
10	(1) at least one of the minors possesses an alcoholic
11	beverage or an illegal drug; and
12	(2) at least five of the minors are not related to the
13	owner of the dwelling.
14	(b) The governing body of a municipality may declare a
15	gathering described by Subsection (a) a public nuisance.
16	(c) For purposes of the prosecution of an offense under an
17	ordinance adopted under this section, the following are admissible
18	as evidence and create a presumption that a minor possessed an
19	alcoholic beverage or an illegal drug:

that it is an affirmative defense to prosecution if the defendant
