3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 157.062, Family Code, is amended to read
5	as follows:
6	Sec. 157.062. NOTICE OF HEARING. (a) The notice of
7	hearing must include the date, time, and place of the hearing.
8	(b) The notice of hearing need not repeat the allegations
9	contained in the motion for enforcement.
10	(c) Notice of hearing on a motion for enforcement of an
11	existing order providing for child support or possession of or
12	access to a child shall be given to the respondent by personal
13	service of a copy of the motion and notice not later than the 10th
14	business day before the date of the hearing.
15	(d) If a motion for enforcement is joined with another
16	claim:
17	(1) the hearing may not be held before 10 a.m. on the
18	first Monday after the 20th day after the date of service; and
19	(2) the provisions of the Texas Rules of Civil
20	Procedure applicable to the filing of an original lawsuit apply.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
24	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
