- 5 SECTION 1. Section 614.021, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 614.021. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter
- 8 applies only to a complaint against:
- 9 (1) a law enforcement officer of the State of Texas,
- 10 including an officer of the Department of Public Safety or of the
- 11 Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission;
- 12 (2) a fire fighter [who is not covered by a civil
- 13 service statute]; or
- 14 (3) a police officer [who is not covered by a civil
- 15 service statute].
- SECTION 2. Section 614.023, Government Code, is amended by
- 17 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 18 (a-1) If a law enforcement officer, fire fighter, or police
- officer is required to respond to a complaint against the officer or
- 20 fire fighter, a copy of the signed complaint shall be given to the
- 21 officer or fire fighter within a reasonable time before the date on
- 22 which the officer or fire fighter is required to respond.
- 23 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 24 in relation to a complaint filed on or after the effective date of

- 1 this Act. A complaint filed before the effective date of this Act
- 2 is governed by the law in effect on the date the complaint was
- 3 filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
