4	SECTION 1. Section 26.301, Water Code, is amended by adding
5	Subdivision (5) to read as follows:
6	(5) "Liquid waste handling system" means a system in
7	which fresh water or wastewater is used for the transportation and
8	land application of waste.
9	SECTION 2. Section 26.302, Water Code, is amended by adding
10	Subsections (b-1) and (d) to read as follows:
11	(b-1) The State Soil and Water Conservation Board may
12	certify a water quality management plan for a poultry facility if
13	the poultry facility:
14	(1) does not use a liquid waste handling system; and
15	(2) is required to obtain a permit or other
16	authorization from the commission.
17	(d) This section does not affect the authority of the
18	commission to investigate or take enforcement action against a
19	point source discharge under Section 26.121.

- 20 SECTION 3. Subsection (e), Section 201.026, Agriculture
- 21 Code, as added by Section 1, Chapter 1189, Acts of the 77th
- 22 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 23 (e) At the request of the landowner, the state board may
- 24 develop and certify a water quality management plan for any

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- 1 agricultural or silvicultural land in the state. <u>Section</u>
- 2 26.302(b-1), Water Code, applies to a water quality management plan
- 3 developed or certified for use by a poultry facility under this
- 4 section.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
