11	burning.
12	(b) The commission by rule shall authorize outdoor burning
13	of waste if the waste:
14	(1) consists of trees, brush, grass, leaves, branch
15	trimmings, or other plant growth; and
16	(2) is burned:
17	(A) in an area that meets the national ambient
18	air quality standards; and
19	(B) on the property on which it was generated and
20	by the owner of the property.
21	(c) Rules adopted under Subsection (b) may not:
22	(1) require prior commission approval of the burning;

24	(2) authorize the burning only when no practical
