## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to benefits for certain members of the Texas National
- 3 Guard and armed forces of the United States.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 2170, Government Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 2170.011 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2170.011. PREPAID CALLING CARDS. (a) The department
- 8 shall make a bulk purchase of prepaid long distance calling cards
- 9 that may be used to call military personnel stationed in a foreign
- 10 country.

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- 11 (b) The department shall sell the prepaid long distance
- 12 <u>calling cards to members of the National Guard on federal active</u>
- duty and members of the armed forces of the United States on active
- 14 duty, and their families.
- (c) The department may not sell a prepaid long distance
- 16 calling card for more than the cost of the card.
- 17 SECTION 2. (a) Subchapter L, Chapter 2301, Occupations
- 18 Code, is amended by adding Section 2301.557 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 2301.557. TERMINATION OF VEHICLE LEASE BY PERSON ON
- 20 ACTIVE DUTY IN MILITARY. (a) A person, or the spouse of a person,
- 21 who enters United States military service under a call or order,
- 22 including a call of Texas National Guard members to federal active
- 23 service, specifying a period of at least 180 days may terminate a
- vehicle lease that is executed by or on behalf of the person.

- 1 (b) A vehicle lease is not terminated under this section
- 2 until:
- 3 (1) the person described by Subsection (a) or the
- 4 person's spouse gives the lessor notice by certified mail, return
- 5 receipt requested, of the person's intent to terminate the lease
- 6 together with a copy of the military orders calling the person to
- 7 <u>active duty; and</u>
- 8 (2) the vehicle subject to the lease is returned to the
- 9 <u>custody or control of the lessor not later than the 15th day after</u>
- 10 the date of delivery of the notice.
- (c) An unpaid lease amount for a period preceding the
- 12 effective date of the lease termination under this section shall be
- 13 paid on a prorated basis. The lessor may not impose an early
- 14 termination charge, but any taxes, costs of summons, and title or
- 15 registration fees and any other obligation and liability of the
- 16 <u>lessee under the terms of the lease</u>, including reasonable charges
- 17 to the lessee for excess wear, use, and mileage, that are due and
- 18 unpaid at the time of the lease termination shall be paid by the
- 19 lessee.
- 20 (d) The lessor shall refund to the lessee any lease amount
- 21 paid in advance by the lessee applicable to a period after the
- 22 <u>effective date of the lease termination</u>. The refund required by
- this subsection must be paid not later than the 30th day after the
- 24 effective date of the lease termination.
- 25 (b) Section 2301.557, Occupations Code, as added by this
- 26 Act, applies only to a vehicle lease entered into on or after the
- 27 effective date of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 3. Subchapter A, Chapter 17, Utilities Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Section 17.008 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 17.008. RELIEF FOR CERTAIN MEMBERS OF ARMED FORCES.
- 4 (a) In this section, "service member" means a member of the United
- 5 States armed forces or a member of the Texas National Guard called
- 6 to federal active duty.
- 7 (b) An electric utility, retail electric provider, power
- 8 generation company, aggregator, or other entity that provides
- 9 retail electric service may not disconnect service to a residential
- 10 <u>customer who is a service member or a dependent of a service member</u>
- during a period in which the service member is on active duty. The
- 12 entity providing service shall defer collection of the full payment
- of bills that are due during a period in which the service member is
- on active duty until after the period is over and shall work with
- the customer to establish a pay schedule for deferred bills.
- SECTION 4. Subchapter F, Chapter 104, Utilities Code, is
- amended by adding Section 104.259 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 104.259. DISCONNECTION OF GAS SERVICE; CERTAIN MEMBERS
- 19 OF ARMED SERVICES. (a) In this section:
- 20 (1) "Provider" means:
- 21 (A) a gas utility, as defined by Sections 101.003
- 22 and 121.001; and
- (B) an owner, operator, or manager of a mobile
- 24 home park or apartment who purchases natural gas through a master
- 25 meter for delivery to a dwelling unit in a mobile home park or
- apartment house under Chapter 124.
- 27 (2) "Service member" means a member of the United

- 1 States armed forces or a member of the Texas National Guard called
- 2 to federal active duty.
- 3 (b) A provider may not disconnect natural gas service to a
- 4 residential customer who is a service member or a dependent of a
- 5 service member during a period in which the service member is on
- 6 active duty. The provider shall defer collection of the full
- 7 payment of bills that are due during a period in which the service
- 8 member is on active duty until after the period is over and shall
- 9 work with the customer to establish a pay schedule for deferred
- 10 bills.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
