4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 1, Title 28, Revised Statutes, is
6	amended by adding Article to read as follows:
7	Art MUNICIPAL VALIDATION FOR TOWN OF SOUTH PADRE
8	ISLAND.
9	Sec. 1. An annexation or attempted annexation by the Town of
10	South Padre Island that occurred after May 1, 2004 and before
11	January 1, 2005 is validated as of the date it occurred.
12	Sec. 2. This article does not apply to:
13	(1) an annexation or attempted annexation that was
14	void at the time it occurred;
15	(2) an annexation or attempted annexation that, under
16	a statute of this state, was a misdemeanor or felony at the time the
17	act or proceeding occurred;
18	(3) an incorporation or attempted incorporation of a
19	municipality within the incorporated boundaries or
20	extraterritorial jurisdiction of another municipality that
21	occurred without the consent of the other municipality in violation
22	of Chapter 42 or 43, Local Government Code;
23	(4) an ordinance that, at the time it was passed, was
24	preempted by a statute of this state or the United States, including

1	Section 1.06 or 109.57, Alcoholic Beverage Code; or
2	(5) a matter that on the effective date of this
3	article:
4	(A) is involved in litigation if the litigation
5	ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final
6	judgment of a court; or
7	(B) has been held invalid by a final judgment of a
8	<u>court.</u>
9	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
10	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
11	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
12	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

13 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
