5 SECTION 1. Section 11.201, Education Code, is amended by

- 8 (c) For purposes of this subsection, "severance payment"
- 9 means any amount paid by the board of trustees of an independent

10 school district to or in behalf of a superintendent on early

11 termination of the superintendent's contract that exceeds the

12 amount earned by the superintendent under the contract as of the

date of termination, including any amount that exceeds the amount

of earned standard salary and benefits that is paid as a condition

of early termination of the contract. The board of trustees that

makes a severance payment to a superintendent shall report the

terms of the severance payment and the reason for the early

termination of the contract to the commissioner. The commissioner

shall reduce the district's Foundation School Program funds by:

20 <u>(1)</u> [any amount that] the <u>full</u> amount of the severance

21 payment, if the commissioner determines that the contract was

terminated early without good cause; or

23 (2) the portion of the severance payment, if any, that

24 [to the superintendent] exceeds an amount equal to one year's

- 1 salary and benefits under the superintendent's terminated
- 2 contract, if the commissioner determines that the contract was
- 3 terminated early with good cause.
- 4 $\underline{(c-1)}$ The commissioner may adopt rules as necessary to
- 5 administer <u>Subsection (c)</u> [this subsection].
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 11.201(c), Education Code, as amended by
- 7 this Act, applies only to a severance payment made by the board of
- 8 trustees of an independent school district to a superintendent
- 9 under an agreement entered into on or after the effective date of
- 10 this Act. A severance payment made by the board of trustees to a
- 11 superintendent under an agreement entered into before the effective
- 12 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at the time the
- 13 agreement was made, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 14 purpose.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
