6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
8	amended by adding Section 130.0831 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 130.0831. FILING OF FINANCIAL STATEMENT BY TRUSTEE.
10	(a) This section applies only to a junior college district that:
11	(1) has an enrollment of more than 33,000 students;
12	(2) has fewer than six campuses; and
13	(3) has more than seven trustees.
14	(b) This section does not apply to a junior college district
15	which has 10 or more school districts in two counties in its taxing
16	<u>district.</u>
17	(c) A member of the board of trustees of a junior college
18	district shall file the financial statement required of state
19	officers under Subchapter B, Chapter 572, Government Code, with:
20	(1) the board of trustees of the junior college
21	district; and
22	(2) the Texas Ethics Commission.
23	(d) Subchapter B, Chapter 572, Government Code:
24	(1) applies to a trustee of a junior college district

1 as if the trustee were a state officer; and

2 (2) governs the contents, timeliness of filing, and
3 public inspection of a statement filed under this section.

4 (e) A trustee subject to this section commits an offense if
5 the trustee fails to file the statement required by this section.
6 An offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. Chapter 144, Election Code, is amended by adding
Section 144.0021 to read as follows:

9 <u>Sec. 144.0021. CANDIDACY FOR OTHER OFFICE. If an elected</u> 10 <u>officer subject to this chapter becomes a candidate, by announcing</u> 11 <u>an intention to be a candidate or by filing an application for a</u> 12 <u>place on the ballot, for any elected office other than an office</u> 13 <u>covered by this chapter, the announcement or candidacy constitutes</u> 14 <u>an automatic resignation of the office held, and the vacancy</u> 15 <u>created shall be filled as provided by applicable law.</u>

SECTION 3. Section 253.004, Election Code, is amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

18 (a-1) Funds collected or held by a political committee
19 established in connection with a candidacy for an elected office
20 covered by Chapter 144 may not be expended for any other purpose.
21 This subsection does not apply to a charitable contribution.

22 SECTION 4. Section 130.0831, Education Code, as added by 23 this Act, applies beginning January 1, 2007. A trustee subject to 24 Section 130.0831, Education Code, as added by this Act, is not 25 required to include financial activity occurring before January 1, 26 2006, in a financial disclosure statement required under Section 27 130.0831, Education Code, as added by this Act.
