- 4 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 19.03, Penal Code, is 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A person commits an offense if the person commits murder 7 as defined under Section 19.02(b)(1) and:
- 8 (1) the person murders a peace officer or fireman who
- 9 is acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty and who the
- 10 person knows is a peace officer or fireman;
- 11 (2) the person intentionally commits the murder in the
- 12 course of committing or attempting to commit kidnapping, burglary,
- 13 robbery, aggravated sexual assault, arson, obstruction or
- 14 retaliation, or terroristic threat under Section 22.07(a)(1), (3),

- 16 (3) the person commits the murder for remuneration or
- 17 the promise of remuneration or employs another to commit the murder
- 18 for remuneration or the promise of remuneration;
- 19 (4) the person commits the murder while escaping or
