- 14 <u>(b) A surgical assistant described by this section shall be</u>
 15 <u>reimbursed on the same basis as a physician assistant, nurse</u>
 16 <u>practitioner, or clinical nurse specialist who functions as a first</u>
- assistant in surgery.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a claim for workers' compensation benefits based on a compensable injury that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. A claim based on a compensable injury that occurs before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date that the compensable injury occurred, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
