- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 408, Labor Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 408.0295 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 408.0295. SURGICAL ASSISTANT SERVICES. (a) An
- 8 insurance carrier may not refuse to reimburse a health care
- 9 practitioner solely because the practitioner is a surgical
- 10 assistant licensed under Chapter 206, Occupations Code, for a
- 11 covered service that a physician providing health care services
- 12 under this subtitle has requested the surgical assistant to
- 13 <u>perform.</u>

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- 14 (b) A surgical assistant described by this section shall be
- 15 reimbursed on the same basis as a physician assistant, nurse
- 16 practitioner, or clinical nurse specialist who functions as a first
- 17 assistant in surgery.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a claim for workers'
- 19 compensation benefits based on a compensable injury that occurs on
- 20 or after the effective date of this Act. A claim based on a
- 21 compensable injury that occurs before that date is governed by the
- law in effect on the date that the compensable injury occurred, and
- 23 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
